Dear Patients of Dr. Brian Yong,

I am writing to inform you that, effective August 1st, 2025, I will no longer be practising at Victoria Medical Centre. I will be relocating my practice to Harvard Place Medical Clinic, located at 530 Kingsway, Vancouver, BC. ***Please do not contact the new clinic prior to August 1st, 2025.***

I will continue to care for my patients at the new location, and arrangements will be made to transfer your medical chart to Harvard Place Clinic at no cost to you. However, please note that due to a variety of factors, I will **be reducing my clinic hours**, which may result in **longer wait times** for appointments.

Over time, I will need to determine if the reduction in my clinic hours leads to concerns with my ability to ensure safe and timely care. If this were the case, **I may need to reduce the number of patients under my care in the future.**

If this change may cause inconvenience or if you feel that a different provider may better meet your needs, I encourage you to take this opportunity to seek an alternate primary care provider. On the following page, you will find resources to help you in your search.
